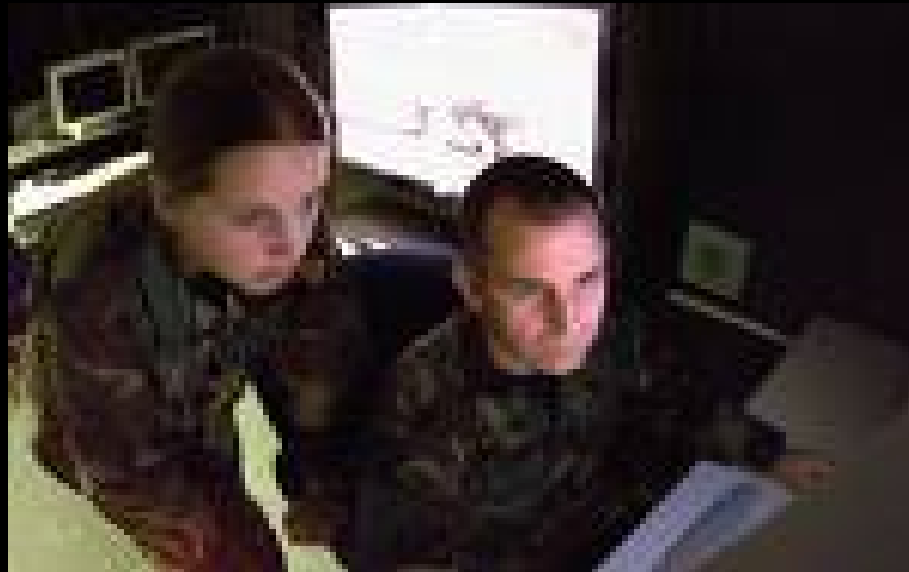

UNMANNED AERIAL SYSTEMS

- Fills the need for constant surveillance
- Presents new challenges to Imagery Analysts because of the massive amount of data obtained during a mission to include full motion video
- Can conduct the same amount of reconnaissance in a twelve hour period that it would take ground based teams weeks to accomplish

THE CONCEPTS OF IMAGERY ANALYSIS HAS CHANGED OVER THE PAST TWENTY YEARS

- During the cold war forces were stationary
- Imagery Analyst training focused on recognition and association with organic units
- Doctrine of the period dictated equipment movement as whole units so when a single piece of equipment was found it's parent organization had to be nearby
- The enemy wore standard uniforms

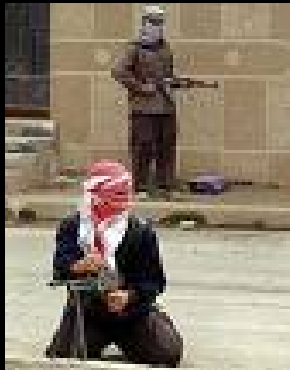
YESTERDAY'S INSURGENT



TODAY'S BATTLEFIELD IS A DIVERSE MIX COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS "ASYMMETRICAL WARFARE"

- No longer does the enemy operate conventional pieces of equipment nor do they wear standard uniforms
- Weapons are very diverse in origin
- The enemy could be "*the barber, the butcher, or the farmer's son*"
- No longer is there a distinct difference between the local population and the enemy forces

CRITICAL THINKING IS ESSENTIAL

- Critical Thinking is a talent that must be developed to be truly effective
- It involves the ability to scan the whole area and make educated assessments based on observations
- One must be able to distinguish what's normal behavioral patterns and what is not based on known cultural behavior trends
- Complacency is no longer acceptable

A GOOD ANALYST NEEDS TO BE A GOOD CRITICAL THINKER

- Always trying to determine why something is occurring at any particular time of the day based on what they have seen before
- Must have a working knowledge of local culture such as holidays, festivals, and religious customs
- Should maintain a knowledge of current events that affect the local populous

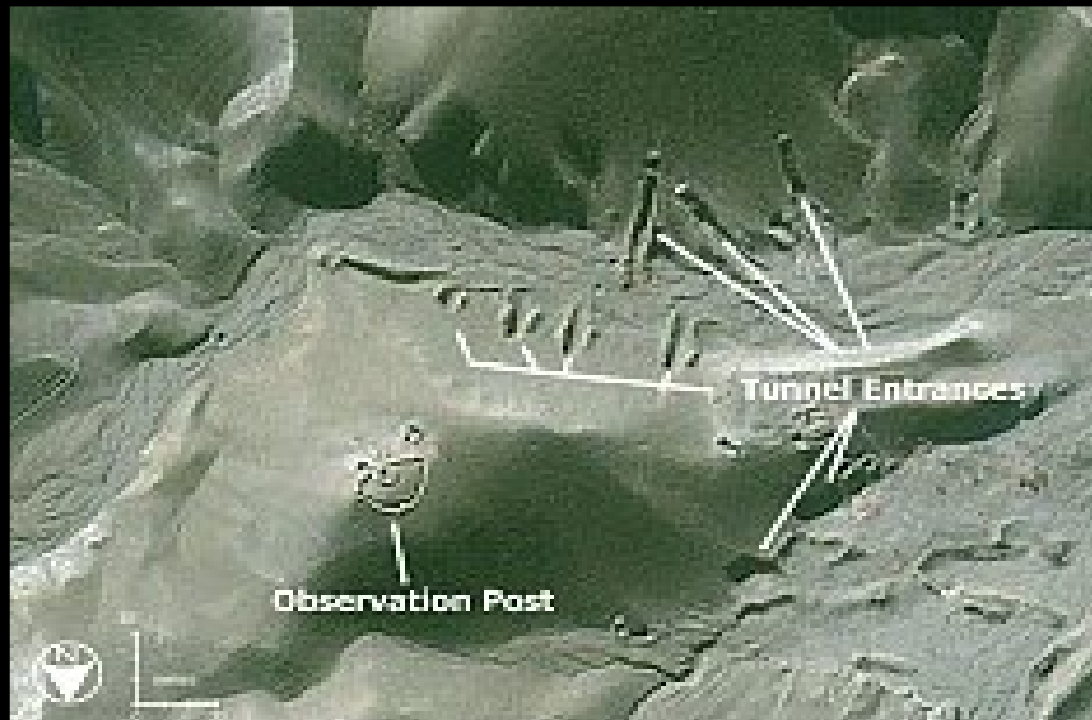
INTELLIGENCE SURVEILLANCE AND RECONNAISSANCE

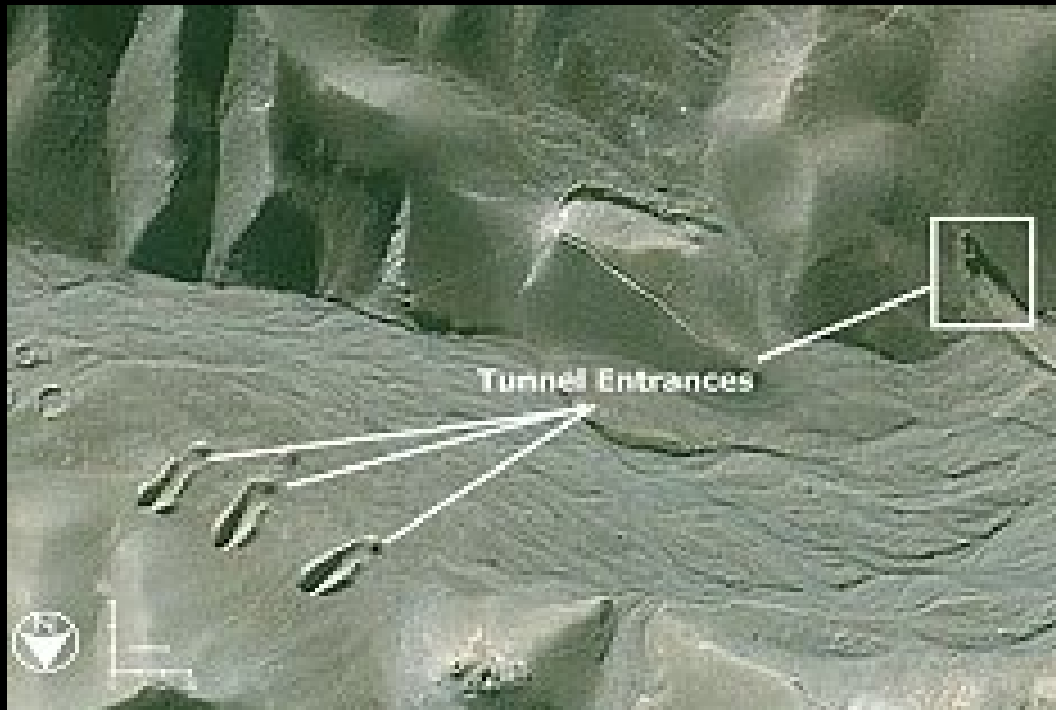

What is the observation post observing?



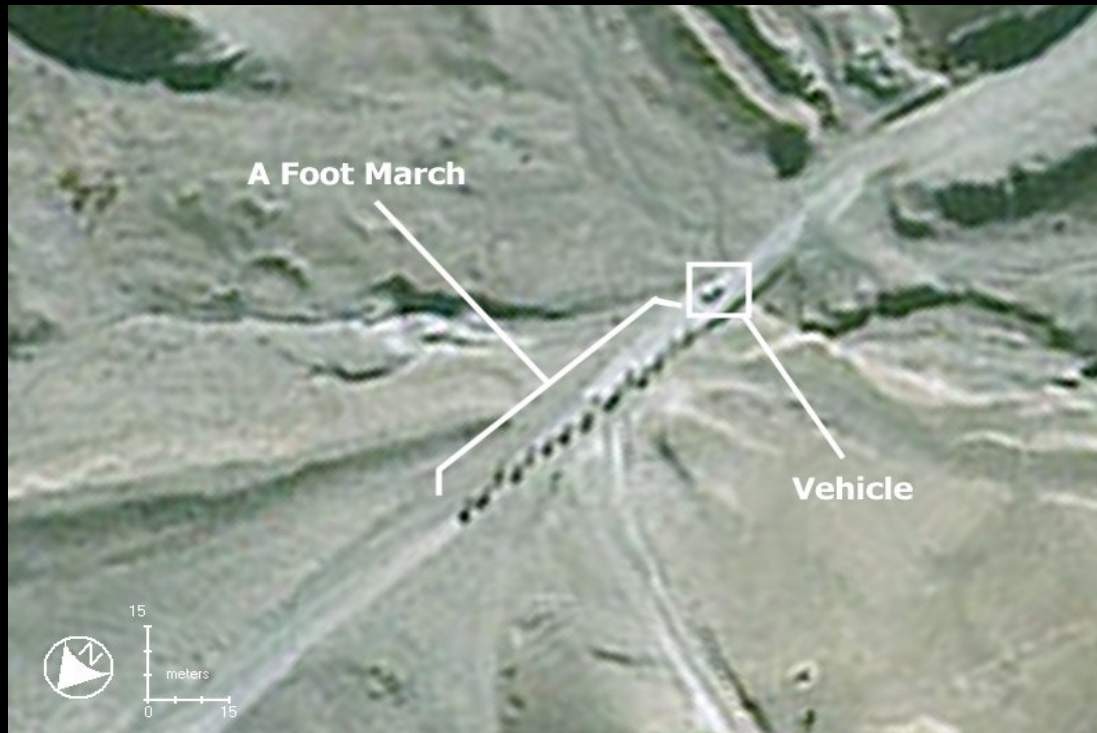
Tunnel entrances and Observation Post
